SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Event: Vinexpo Discover India, (the “Event”) will be held at the Taj Lands End in Mumbai on 15 & 16 October, 2026.

Submission for Exhibitor: This application for exhibiting at the “Event” will become a binding agreement upon the acceptance by **Comexposium India LLP** (hereinafter referred to as “**Comexposium**”), based upon the available inventory and general information listed on this form that constitutes a part of this Agreement.

Payment: 50% payment on signing the booking form and balance 50% by July 31, 2026. Any contract signed after July 31, 2026 - 100% payment will be applicable. If your company fails to meet the payment terms, Comexposium reserves the right to rescind your participation. Cancellation penalties will be assessed in accordance with item 13 in the Specific Terms and Conditions hereto and made a part hereof.

Cancellation fee: Cancellation charges in accordance with item 13 as per these Terms and Conditions

1. General Matters. Comexposium obligation to hold the Event is conditioned upon the facility making available the space applied for by Comexposium on the dates specified. Comexposium has the sole right to determine the eligibility of any company or product for inclusion in the Event. Comexposium makes no representation or warranty, express or implied, regarding the number of persons who will attend the Event.

2. Assignment, Use of Space. Comexposium shall assign symmetrical exhibit space to the Exhibitor for the period of the Event only and does not imply that the same or similar space will be held or offered for future Events etc. Comexposium reserves the right to withdraw its acceptance of this application and to cancel Exhibitor's participation in the Event if it determines that Exhibitor is not eligible to participate or Exhibitor's goods/services are not eligible to be displayed. Exhibitor should not assign or sublet its exhibit space, or any part thereof (including so-called “booth sharing”), nor exhibit, offer for sale, or advertise articles not manufactured or sold by the exhibiting company, except where such articles are necessary for the proper demonstration or operation of Exhibitor's display, in which case the identification shall be limited to the manufacturer's normal, regular nameplate. Exhibitor may not permit non-exhibiting company representatives to operate from or share its booth. Under no circumstances shall any demonstration or event interfere with the neighbouring exhibitor or the general movement around the Event and, more generally, with the proper running of the Event. Failing this, approval may be revoked without warning. Decisions of Comexposium regarding use of exhibit space shall, in all instances, be final and binding.

3. Relocation; Floor Plan Revisions. Comexposium reserves, to itself, the exclusive right to revise floor plans and/or move assigned exhibitors as it deems necessary. Comexposium will provide a written notice to the Exhibitor in the event that this happens. Comexposium will also provide three (3) other options that the Exhibitor can choose from.

4. Occupancy, Payment Defaults. All participation costs must be paid when due, and in any event in full prior to Exhibitor's move-in. If Exhibitor fails to occupy its contracted space, fails to pay any or all fees in a timely manner, or fails to perform, meet or observe any term or condition set forth herein, it shall not be relieved of the obligation of paying the full cost of its participation in the Event and Comexposium, at its discretion, may cancel this Agreement and Exhibitor's participation in the Event and reassign the exhibit space. In the event that Exhibitor tenders the exhibit fees after such reassignment, Comexposium may assign to it some other exhibit space, if then available, which Comexposium deems appropriate. Exhibitor shall not be entitled to any refund of any part of any fee and shall remain liable for payment of all fees set forth in this agreement, subject only to the applicable cancellation schedule herein.

In the event of late payment of any sum payable to Comexposium, interest will be charged at the rate mentioned in the invoice from the date on which the sum in question was originally due and payable. Any collection costs are to be borne by the Exhibitor. All amounts invoiced are payable without any deduction with all bank charges onto any of the bank accounts stated on invoice

5. Installing, Exhibiting, and Dismantling. The Exhibitor shall be responsible for ensuring the safety of its Exhibit Space during the construction, operation, and dismantling of its stand. The Exhibitor owes a duty of care to all persons on or near the Exhibit Space who may be

affected by the acts or omissions of the Exhibitor or its Representatives. Hours and dates for installing, exhibiting and dismantling shall be those specified by Comexposium. All displays must be fully set up by the opening of the Event, and all exhibits must be open for business during all Event hours. In addition, Exhibitor may not dismantle or pack any portion of its display until the Event officially closes. Exhibitor shall be liable for all storage and handling charges resulting from failure to remove exhibit material from the Event before conclusion of the dismantling period. When vacated, all exhibit space shall be left in good order.

6. Contractor Services and Information. Comexposium shall select and/or approve each contractor to provide support and facilities services. Comexposium assumes no responsibility for failure of performance by, or the conduct of, any contractor or subcontractor or its employees.

7. Observance of Laws and Regulations. Exhibitor shall ensure that all contractors, sub-agents, and temporary staff engaged by it shall abide by and observe all laws, rules, regulations, codes and ordinances, including labour laws and occupational health and safety requirements issued by Comexposium or any applicable government authority and all rules of the Facility and the jurisdiction in which the Facility is located (now in effect or herein after promulgated).

Comexposium shall not be responsible for any exposure to illness, disease, viruses, or infections occurring at the Event. Exhibitors are advised to take appropriate precautions, including vaccination where applicable, and to follow all recommended health and safety measures.

8. Attendance; Hours. Admission policies and Event hours shall remain, at all times, the prerogative of Comexposium, and may be revised or amended to suit unforeseen conditions.

9. Exhibitor Conduct. Exhibitor, and each of its employees and representatives, shall conduct itself in a manner that does not annoy, endanger, obstruct, or interfere with the rights of other exhibitors, attendees, visitors, Comexposium, or the Facility owner. Comexposium reserves the right to reject, eject or prohibit any exhibit, in whole or in part, or any exhibitor or its representatives or invitees, with or without given cause. Furthermore, Comexposium may at its sole discretion, prohibit any conduct or feature it deems objectionable, including but not limited to ceiling hangings, excessive noise (exceeding 50 decibels), flashing lights, or any other activity that results in complaints or constitutes a nuisance, interference, or risk to others. Any conduct by the Exhibitor or its Representatives that causes unreasonable interference, disruption, or inconvenience to the Event, other exhibitors, attendees, visitors, Comexposium, or the Venue owner shall constitute a material breach of the Contract. In the event of such breach, Comexposium may terminate the Contract immediately without notice, if cause is not given, Comexposium liability therefore shall not exceed the return of the amount of rental unearned at the time of ejection. If Exhibitor or any portion of its exhibit is ejected for violation of applicable rules or for any other reason, no refund of exhibit fees or payment by Comexposium of other amounts shall be made. Where termination occurs during the Event, the Exhibitor shall be required to immediately vacate the Venue. Any dispute regarding such termination shall be determined after the Event.

10. Booth Personnel. Exhibitor representatives (i.e. Booth Personnel) must be at least 18 years of age and are restricted to personnel engaged in the display,

demonstration, application or sale of the company's product or services. The Exhibitor is responsible for ensuring that its representatives are appropriately dressed and conduct themselves in a professional and business-like manner at all times. Booth personnel shall wear Exhibitor badge identification at all times while they are in the exhibit area and will not be granted access to the event without such badges. Badges are non-transferable, and if transferred to or used by any party other than the individual to whom it was issued, may be cancelled by Comexposium in its absolute discretion. All other employees of exhibiting companies must register as Show Attendees. Comexposium reserves the right to restrict or limit the number of booth representatives. Furthermore, Comexposium shall have no obligation or liability in respect of compensation, taxes, withholdings, employee benefits, or insurance for any Exhibitor Representatives.

11. Cancellation of Event. Investment can be moved to the next event if postponed. If for any reason beyond Comexposium's control (e.g., fire, casualty, flood, epidemic, earthquake, explosion, accident, blockage, embargo, inclement weather, governmental restraints, act of public enemy, riot or civil disturbance, impairment or lack of adequate transportation, inability to secure sufficient labor, technical or other personnel, municipal, state or territory laws, or act of God), the Event, or any part thereof, is prevented from being held, or the Facility becomes unavailable, unfit for occupancy or substantially interfered with, Comexposium may cancel the Event. In such event, Comexposium shall not be responsible for delays, damage, loss, increased costs, or other unfavorable conditions arising by virtue thereof, and Exhibitor declares to waive any such claims for damage arising there from. Upon any such termination, Comexposium may refund to Exhibitor no more than a prorated amount of Exhibitor's total cost of participation paid after deducting all expenses and reasonable compensation to Comexposium. In no case shall the amount of any refund exceed Exhibitor's total cost of participation actually paid.

12. Postponement of Event. If for any reason Comexposium determines that the location or dates of an Event should be changed, no full refund will be due to Exhibitor, if Exhibitor chooses not to participate in the event, in lieu of the changes. If Exhibitor chooses to participate, Exhibitor will choose a new space, in lieu of the original space. Comexposium will give a written notice at least one month prior to the Event if postponement of event happens.

13. Exhibitor Cancellation. If Exhibitor desires to cancel this Agreement, Exhibitor may only do so by giving written notice thereof to Comexposium, Attention: Show Manager, in all communications of the contract. In such event, Exhibitor shall be liable for the following cancellation fee: (i) 66% of the total cost (i.e. including GST if applicable on the original invoice) of Exhibitor's participation if such cancellation is effective more than 180 days prior to scheduled opening of Event; and (ii) 100% of the total cost (i.e. including GST if applicable on the original invoice) of Exhibitor's participation if such cancellation is effective within 180 days prior to scheduled opening of Event.

In the event of cancellation, the applicable GST on the said cancellation fee shall also be levied and deducted, and the balance amount, if any, shall be refundable to the Exhibitor. Comexposium shall, within 30 (thirty) days from the date of cancellation, refund to the Exhibitor the balance amount, if any, remaining after deduction of the

applicable cancellation fee and corresponding GST as applicable thereon, as per the terms of this agreement. The effective date of any cancellation shall be the date Comexposium actually receives Exhibitor's written notice as specified above. Exhibitor understands this cancellation fee has been incorporated into this Agreement as a valid pre-estimate of damages. Comexposium will sustain, which will not be capable of precise determination thereof, and is thus considered to be liquidated and agreed-upon damages suffered not a penalty but as a result of Exhibitor's cancellation only. Subsequent reassignment of cancelled exhibit space shall not affect the enforceability or recovery of such charges. In addition all decorating expenses Comexposium incurs in decorating that cancelled exhibit space shall be due and payable to Comexposium from the Exhibitor upon demand. The refunds shall be adequately supported by credit notes which will be issued within 30 days of intimation of cancellation by the Exhibitor. In case credit Notes are issued on or before 30th November of the financial year succeeding the financial year in which the invoice was issued. GST charged originally shall also be refunded. In case credit note is issued after 30th November of financial year, succeeding the financial year in which the invoice was issued, no refund or adjustment of such GST amount shall be claimed from Comexposium.

14. Exhibitor Downsizing. In the event of any cancellation or variation of Value Added Services (VAS) by the Exhibitor, or other Content, no refund shall be made in respect of any VAS charges already paid. The Exhibitor must provide written notice to Comexposium of any downsizing. The date of receipt of such notice by Comexposium shall be deemed the effective date ("Effective Date") of the downsizing. Any request for downsizing must be submitted at least forty-five (45) days prior to the commencement of the event. The parties acknowledge that the losses arising from cancellation or downsizing are difficult to quantify, as Comexposium incurs costs, allocates resources, and undertakes commitments in preparation for the Event. Accordingly, in the event of downsizing by the Exhibitor, Comexposium shall be entitled to retain all amounts paid by the Exhibitor. The parties agree that such amount represents a genuine pre-estimate of costs and are not a penalty. Comexposium reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to refuse any request by the Exhibitor to downsize its Exhibit Space. Such refusal shall not prejudice the Exhibitor's right to cancel its participation. The Exhibitor shall not be permitted to downsize its originally agreed Exhibit Space within forty-five (45) days prior to the commencement of the Event. In such cases, the Exhibitor shall not be entitled to any refund or compensation for any unused Exhibit Space. If the Exhibitor fails to occupy or staff its Exhibit Space at the commencement of the Event for any reason whatsoever, Comexposium may treat such failure as a cancellation of participation. In such circumstances, Comexposium shall be entitled to reallocate the Exhibit Space at its discretion, and the Exhibitor shall not be entitled to any refund or compensation.

15. Copyrighted Materials. Exhibitor shall not violate any copyrights with respect to writings, music or other materials used by it at the Event or at any affiliated function, and assumes sole liability and responsibility for the use and display of all copyrighted materials at an Event, and shall obtain any and all necessary licenses therefore. Exhibitor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Comexposium, its licensors (including Comexposium, any association owner or Exhibitor, the Facility, and their respective officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives, from and against any and all actions, causes of action, claims, demands, liabilities, losses, damages, costs and expenses, of whatever kind and nature, which any one and/or each of them shall sustain, incur or become subject to, involving, arising from, or relating to, Exhibitor's breach of any of its obligations contained herein or the use of copyrighted materials at the Event or any affiliated function.

16. Illicit Ticket Touting. The act of offering for sale or showing with the intention to sell or transfer or supplying with the intention to sell or transfer any Event access passes (entry passes, invitations, tickets etc.) in a public or private place or on the Internet, without the authorisation of Comexposium, is a criminal offence punishable as per the applicable laws.

17. Catalogue. Only Comexposium is authorised to publish, have re-published and distribute the Event catalogue. All information required by the catalogue publishing team will be supplied by the Exhibitors, who remain responsible for it. Under no circumstances will Comexposium be liable for any omissions or reproduction, composition or other errors that may occur.

18. Photos/Brands. The Exhibitor, for no charge, expressly authorises Comexposium to:

- take, should they wish to do so, photos and/or videos featuring the Exhibitor and/or members of its team, as well as any products exhibited at its stand,
- use any such images freely on all media and in particular for the purposes of advertising (including on the internet) in India and worldwide for a period of five (5) years beginning from the date of this agreement,

- cite and reproduce, for no charge, its trade mark and company name as a commercial reference for the purposes of communication on any media (including the internet) in India and worldwide for a period of five (5) years beginning from the date of this agreement.

- Where applicable, represent, broadcast, reproduce, adapt, record, edit, translate, use, exploit at no cost the materials provided by the Exhibitor during the Event which the latter certifies being the owner of the copyrights or certifies having received all the required authorisations from the owner of the copyrights, and also the interventions of the Exhibitor for the purposes of communication on any media (including the internet) in India and worldwide for a period of five (5) years beginning from the date of this agreement.

Any Exhibitor who does not wish for all or part of their stand or any elements thereon (logo, trade mark, model) or any members of their team to appear in photographs or films and/or on the Internet by way of advertising material promoting the Event, must advise Comexposium of this in writing before the beginning of the Event.

Furthermore, any Exhibitor wishing to take photographs of the Event must inform Comexposium in writing beforehand. Given this, the Exhibitor will personally ensure it possesses all necessary authorisations to take photographs at the Event and is exclusively responsible for complying with any image rights enjoyed by Exhibitor, public or any other participant to the Event.

19. Limitation of Liability; Indemnity. None of Comexposium, its licensors and its affiliates or the Facility, or officers, agents, employees or other representatives, shall be held liable for, and each is hereby released from any damages, losses, harm, or injury to the person or property of Exhibitor or any of its visitors, officers, agents, employees or other representatives, resulting from Exhibitor's participation in the Event which might result or arise from its participation in the Event. Exhibitor understands that none of Comexposium, maintains insurance covering Exhibitor's liability or property, and Exhibitor is advised to obtain, at its sole expense, insurance for its exhibit material and products against loss or damage, and public liability insurance against injury to the person or property of others. It is understood that all property of Exhibitor is in its care, custody, and control in transit to, or from, or within the confines of the Facility, and Exhibitor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Comexposium to any responsibility whatsoever. In no event shall Comexposium be liable to Exhibitor or anyone claiming through Exhibitor for incidental, consequential, special or indirect damages, including lost profits, even if Comexposium has been appraised of the possibility of such loss.

20. Damage to Facility. The Exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and liability for losses, damages and claims arising out of injury or damages caused to Facility floors, walls, or columns, or to standard booth equipment, or to other exhibitors' property, to displays, equipment and other property brought upon the hotel premises, and shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Hotel and Comexposium, its owners, affiliated companies, agents, servants and employees from any and all such losses, damages and claims.

21. Amendment, Interpretation. Comexposium shall have full power in the enforcement and interpretation of all terms, conditions and rules, and the power to make amendments and set further terms, conditions, and rules as it deems necessary and in the best interest of the Event. The connectives "and" and "or" shall be construed both conjunctively and disjunctively, the term "including" shall mean including without limitation, and words in the singular include the plural, and words in the plural include the singular.

22. Agreement to Terms, Conditions and Rules. Exhibitor agrees to observe and abide by the foregoing terms, conditions and rules, those contained in the Exhibitor Service Manual, and by such additional terms, conditions and rules made by Comexposium from time to time for the efficient and safe operation of the Event, all of which constitute a part of this Agreement. The rights of Comexposium under this Agreement shall not be deemed waived except as specifically stated in writing and signed by an authorized representative of Comexposium.

23. Sales Regulations. Retail sales are strictly prohibited during the Event. Any violation of this provision shall entitle Comexposium to immediately shut down the Exhibitor's Exhibit Space and remove the Exhibitor, its

Representatives, and exhibits from the Venue at the Exhibitor's sole cost and expense. The Exhibitor may, at its own risk and responsibility, distribute samples, souvenirs, permitted publications, or similar items, and may conduct promotional activities solely within its designated Exhibit Space. Comexposium retains the sole right and discretion to approve, regulate, or prohibit the distribution of any such items, including determining the manner and location of their distribution. Where Comexposium arranges appointments and/or networking events, the Exhibitor is required to attend scheduled appointments punctually and shall use reasonable endeavours to participate in all networking events.

24. Taxes and Licenses. Exhibitor shall be responsible for obtaining any licenses, permits or approvals required under local or national law applicable to Exhibitor's activity at the show. Exhibitor shall be responsible for obtaining any tax identification number and paying all taxes, license fees or other charges that may become due to any governmental authority concerning Exhibitor's activities at the show.

25. Assignment. Exhibitor Company may not assign or delegate this Agreement (or any of Exhibitor's rights, duties or obligations hereunder) to any third party. However, Comexposium reserves its right to assign the control of event to some other entity even prior to the holding of the event saving all the terms and conditions written herein.

26. Videography. Videography is not allowed to capture any of the conference events including the think:tech and any of the conference sessions.

27. Privacy & Data Protection. For the purposes of the Contract, "Data Protection Legislation" means all applicable laws, regulations, directives, and legal requirements relating to the protection and processing of personal data in any relevant jurisdiction. This includes, without limitation, the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR"), the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003, and any implementing, supplementary, or related legislation applicable within the European Union, the European Economic Area, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom. The Exhibitor shall be deemed a "data controller" under applicable Data Protection Legislation in respect of all personal data it accesses or processes in connection with its participation in the Event, including any visitor data. The Exhibitor shall comply with all obligations applicable to a data controller, including providing all required notices and obtaining all necessary consents for its processing and use of such personal data. The Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for its processing activities and shall bear all liabilities arising from its status as a data controller. Comexposium shall not be liable under any circumstances for any unlawful processing or use of personal data by the Exhibitor or any third party. The Exhibitor shall implement and maintain appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data (including visitor data) against unauthorised or unlawful processing, accidental loss, destruction, or damage. Such measures shall meet the requirements of applicable Data Protection Legislation, including Article 32 of the GDPR (security of processing), and shall ensure a level of protection consistent with applicable legal standards. Personal data provided by the Exhibitor to Comexposium may be processed in accordance with Comexposium's privacy policy. The individual identified as the Exhibitor's contact person in the quotation, Contract, or subsequent communications may be contacted by Comexposium, its affiliates, the Venue, and their service providers for purposes related to the Exhibitor's participation in the Event. Such purposes may include, without limitation, listing the Exhibitor on the Event website and directory, facilitating introductions or meetings with Event attendees, and marketing relevant products and services, in each case in accordance with the applicable privacy policy made available on the Event website.

28. Invalidity. In the event that one or more provisions of these terms and conditions are found to be invalid or declared as such under any law or regulation or following a final court decision, the remaining provisions will remain in force and retain their scope of application.

29. Governing Law. This Agreement, and all matters arising out of or relating to this Agreement and any of the transactions contemplated hereby, including, without limitation, the validity hereof and the rights and obligations of the parties hereunder, shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of India (without giving effect to the conflicts of laws provisions thereof) and courts in [Delhi], India shall have exclusive jurisdiction to entertain any dispute that may arise in relation thereto.
